Father Gartlan Trophy

Father Thomas Gartlan SJ was the founder of the St. Ignatius' College Rowing Club in 1882 and was its first Rowing Master. He was also Headmaster 1901 to 1911 and 1913 to 1919. Father Gartlan continued his keen interest in school rowing up to his death in 1942. This trophy was donated to the AAGPS in his memory by rowers of St. Ignatius' College Rowing Club in the Centenary Year of their Club (1982), for competition amongst the Third Fours.

Yaralla Cup

Dame Edith Walker's name is well-known to generations of GPS oarsmen. Her large house (now a small hospital) at the end of Yaralla Bay marks the start of the old GPS mile-and-a-half course on the Parramatta River. In 1906, Dame Edith presented the handsome Yaralla Cup to the AAGPS for competition in the second crews (in those days, the 2nd IV). After the introduction of Vllls it became the much-prized trophy for the 1st IV event.

Major Rennie Trophy

Major Zenus C. Rennie was an American Civil War veteran who fought for the Union at Baton Rouge in 1862. He arrived in Australia to work for the Mutual Life Insurance Company of New York. In June 1893, Major Rennie's offer of a silver trophy was accepted by the AAGPS as a perpetual trophy for the major event of the Regatta.

From 1893 until 1935, the Regatta was held on the Parramatta River; from 1936 until 1996 on the Nepean River; and since 1996 at the Olympic Course. From 1893 until 1909 the race was contested by four-oared boats, and by eight-oared boats since then. Since 1996 the race has been contested over 2000 metres; all previous events were over a mile and a half, except in 1946 and 1947 when the races were over a mile and a quarter*.

A CENTURY AGO

1925 AAGPS Head of the River – Sydney Boys High School

100 years ago, and on the Parramatta River, Sydney Boys High School enjoyed great success, with victory in both 2nd IV, and the Head of the River, 1st VIII. Not only was this a triumph for the rowing team, but also one for the school - it was their very first senior premiership in GPS sport. The year before, in 1924 and in great excitement, the school had won the 1st IV, the Yaralla Cup.

The conditions were described as splendid with a slight ebb tide and a light north westerly wind, giving an advantage to the crews on the northern side of the river.

“Rowing, of course, provided the school with the greatest of all its sporting victories. Even more significant than the winning of the actual eights championship was the fact that, in two years on the river, we won all three races”.

TRIUMPH !!! The School's First Senior Premiership in any S.B.H. sport! The eight rowed home.. by 6 lengths in the heat and 4 lengths in the Final. The Second Four (coached by Litchfield of the Slane Club) also won their heat and final. The all-conquering Eight was stroked by Ken Robinson from the victorious 1924 crew and R. Mainwaring, F. Weatherstone and H. Johnston from the 1924 crew were also present, with George Hancock the Coach.
